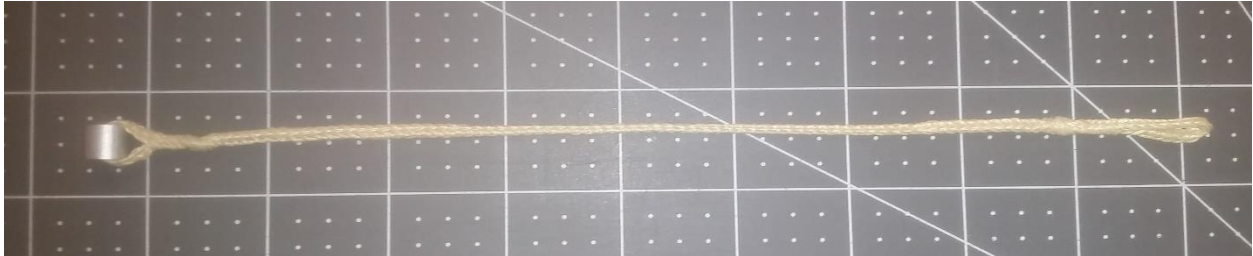


Rigging the Soft Quick Link

Stopper end

Looped End



Warning: Read and follow all instruction when rigging the soft quick link. Inspect the soft quick link after/ before every use to determine serviceability. Failure to inspect or follow instructions can result in injury or damage to property.

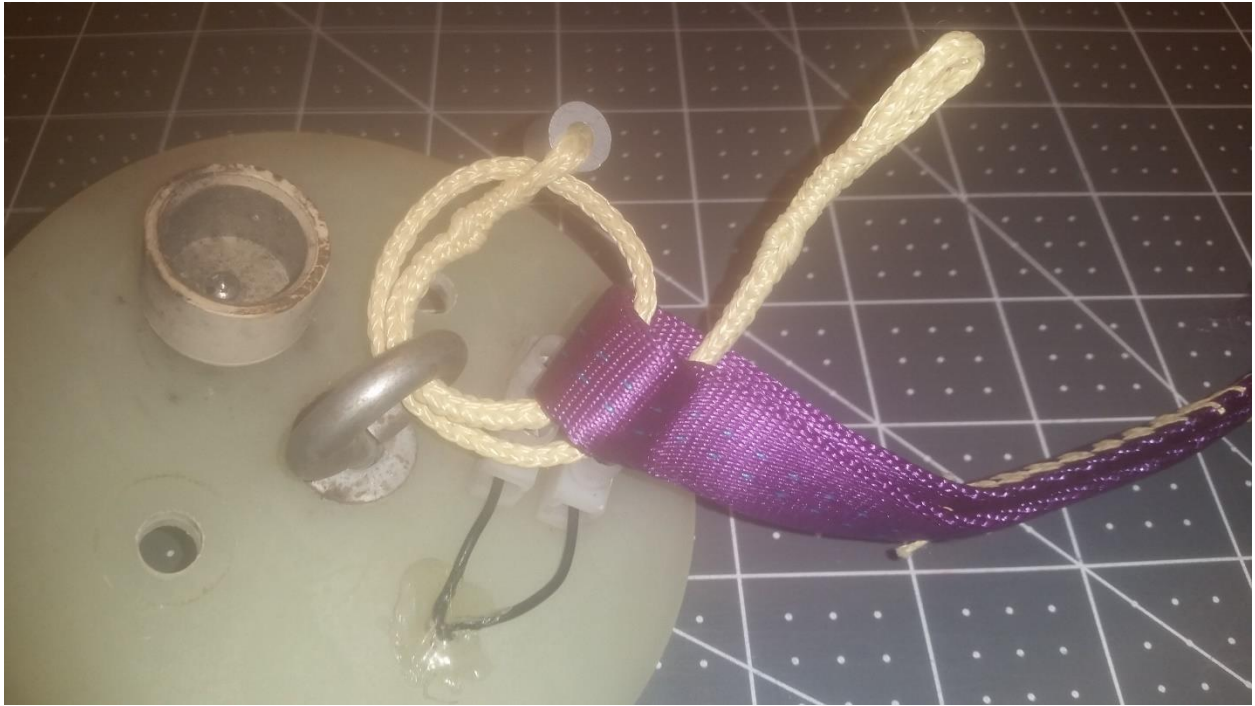
Step 1: Route the looped end through the items being linked together.



Step 2: Route the looped end through the opening on the stopper end.



Step 3: Route the looped end back through the items being linked.



Step 4: Route the looped end through the opening on the stopper end.



Step 5: Route the stopper (aluminum barrel) through the loop on the looped end.



Step 6: Tension the link by either pulling the link in opposite directions with your fingers or by pulling the linked items apart. NOTE: It is very important that the looped end “seats” itself tightly under the stopper.



Step 7: At this point the link is rigged and is safe to use. The link can be “cleaned up” a little by moving the stopper in a position inside of a webbing loop (if available).



De-rigging is a reverse of these instructions
